New York: A male student from Kingston University, University of London, has been denied permission to wear a hijab while studying at the UK's top university, it has emerged. The student was told by his employer that the headgear, considered to be "religious", is a "religious symbol" that is not allowed at the university. The incident occurred during spring term when the student, a Shia Muslim, wore a hijab during a major project presentation. He was offered a choice of a different head covering or no head covering, but was given no option of not wearing it. In an email from the Humanities Faculty, the student was told: "It is the view of the Employer that it is not possible to have any head coverings on campus, whether religious or secular. "The policy is on the campus' terms and conditions and clearly states that the terms and conditions are binding. "We have to be very mindful of the rights of all employees and the student's rights to freedom of religion." The student was forced to remove the head covering in front of a group of more than 40 students from the UK and around the world during the presentation. He was told that he could wear it again later. The student's union and the student union are currently taking the case forward with a complaint to the Equality and Human Rights Commission. Amnesty International said the student's employer should not force him to remove his hijab. John Dalhuisen, Amnesty International's researcher on Europe and Central Asia, said: "If a student has to choose between wearing a headscarf and doing their job, it is outrageous that a student should be told that they are not allowed to wear a headscarf. "Amnesty International urges the university to end this unacceptable practice and to make sure that the religious freedoms of all students and employees are protected in line with European and international law." To start, simply activate the AutoCADmarkup Module. Use the Import button to import your paper documents directly into your model. (New in AutoCAD 2023 – from the command line you can use the tag: -mm). In the Import command, simply select the folder containing the paper files to be imported. Any changes you make to the files on the imported paper will be automatically applied to your model. The Markup Assist function is a powerful tool to guide you through the process of importing paper or PDF documents into your models. First, open a model, and select the Markup Assist button. Now you can type in words like [rectangle] or [circle] into the box. The AutoCADmarkup Module will automatically translate these words into commands, and the command will be displayed. You can then simply press the Tab key to select the command or double-click the command to activate it.
